Instructions for collecting hair samples for DNA Testing by Australian Genetics Testing

Your DNA Kit will contain:

- A white card
- A resealable plastic bag
- A label with the details of the animal being tested
- 1. Check that the details on your label are correct.
 - a) If the name of a sire or dam does not have the full correct name you may not obtain the correct result. The names should include (Imp), (iid)/(iiu) etc. where applicable.
 - b) If the details are incorrect, contact austsportpony@gmail.com for a new label to be sent to you.
- 2. Select at least 30 mane hairs, well forward of the withers (the hair at the withers can sometimes be too fine to be easily tested).
 - a) Wrap the hairs around your finger or a comb as close as possible to the skin.
 - b) Pull firmly and swiftly upward to ensure that the roots/follicles stay with the hair and do not break off. At least half of the hairs must have roots/follicles for testing.
 - c) Keep the sample dry.
- 3. Place the hair strands on the front of the white card.
 - a) Make sure the follicles are on the right hand side and inside the space marked on the card.
 - b) Secure the hair by sticking the identification label over the hairs.
 - c) Trim excess hair but DO NOT TRIM THE ROOTS OR FOLLICLES
 - d) Insert the card into the plastic bag supplies and ensure bag is firmly sealed.
- 4. Sending the sample.
 - a) Place the sealed sample bag into the envelope supplied and mail to the ASPR Federal Office, PO Box 305 Eaglehawk Victoria 3556
 - b) Multiple samples can be mailed in the same envelope but each must be individually sealed in its own plastic bag.
- 5. Storing a hair sample.
 - a) If for any reason you are going to keep a hair sample at home, it must be stored in an air-tight bag in a DRY place. DO NOT put stored hair in your refrigerator or freezer as your sample will become contaminated and unusable.
